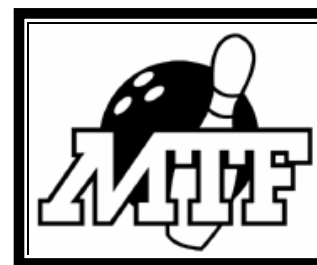

Two types of clinics are offered:

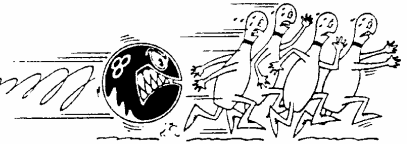

Sutherland currently competes in two mens leagues at Thunderbird Bowl and has been bowling for approximately 20 Years.



For the October camp, one of our coaches – Darren Naylor (who is a major proponent of the camps/programs) came up with creative and fun ways to teach the youth specific techniques. For instance, in order to promote a good follow-through, they were shown that when holding a cup with some water in it, and executing a good follow through, they could give the coach (who was kneeling behind them during the exercise) a little bath. Of course, a lot of them wanted to try this, and Naylor was pretty wet at the end of that.

By making it fun, the coaches got their point across – we saw much-improved follow-throughs for the rest of the camp. We had optical illusions (to help them understand walking straight and targeting), stacking six-sided nuts with chopsticks (to help them understand how to focus), trying to put toothpaste back in the tube (to help him understand that once a poor shot has taken place, you can’t take it back – you must just “move on”), and several more.



In addition, each youth that attended the camp, received a tee shirt when they arrived. They were a hit, and helped the kids feel like they were part of a special event – a “big deal”. The back of each shirt was emblazoned with one of our Manitoba bowling slogans – “*That’s How We Roll !*”



## ***Manitoba Tenpin Bowling Coaches Association Youth Training Camps***

The Manitoba Tenpin Bowling Coaches Association (MTBCA) has implemented a plan to create more development programs for the younger Youth bowlers – specifically, Bantam and Prep. In late summer of 2010, a bowling camp, targeting those bowlers with averages below 120, was held.

This free camp was one day (about 5 hours in total), and included a lunch. Based on the success of that camp, a 12-week development program was piloted for any Bantams and Preps that were interested. One evening a week, these bowlers got to work with coaches, in a structured program. This program was deemed to be a success and for the 2011-12 season, has been expanded to a 20-week program.



In addition to this new development program, there have been several more one-day camps for these lower-average Bantam/Prep bowlers – one in December, 2010 and one in early October, 2011. These low-cost camps focus mostly on the basics, stressing things like approach, swing, follow-through, focus, and targeting, making sure that they get lots of on-lane practice and instruction.

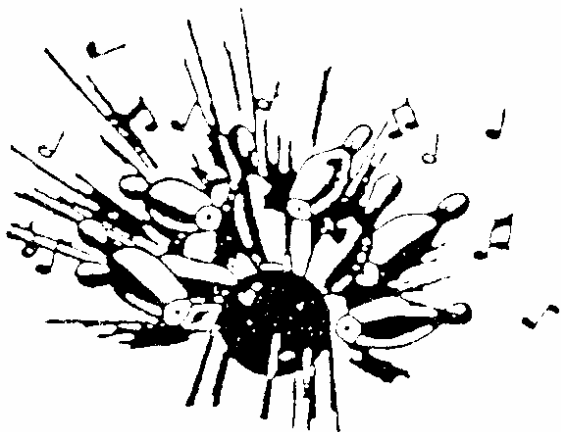

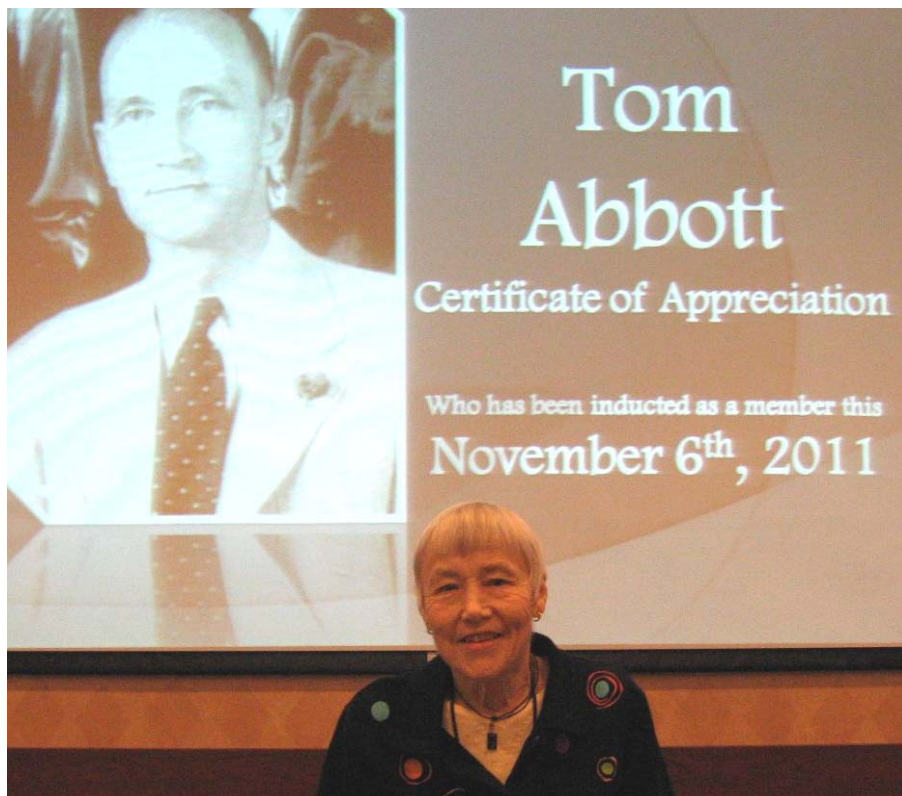
## Ken Hunter
