- 1 All tournaments must be CTF or USBC sanctioned
- Points will be awarded for scratch tournaments and finishes only (except for the annual tournaments as noted in category #12)
- **3** Where tournaments have separate divisions for men and women (e.g. Team Trials), separate points will be awarded
- Where a tournament has no divisions (e.g. Manitoba Open), points will be based on final standings and will be awarded only once for men and women combined
- 5 All sanctioned (CTF or USBC) record scores (1, 3 and 4 game) will be recognized
- 6 Points will be awarded for record scores each time they are bowled
- 7 Any tournament not explicitly listed in this criteria will be included in the category deemed appropriate by the MRA
- **8** House rounds for TSN, World Cup and National Classifieds do not qualify for points as the number of entries fluctuates too greatly
- The CTF National Mixed Championships (singles, regular all-events & senior all-events) will fall into category 10, 11 or 12 depending on the number of entries in each division
- **10** Category #11 will include (but is not limited to):
 - All-events for association annual tournaments
- MCBA tournaments

- Cameo Classic

- Chateau Scratch Classic
- **11** Category #12 will include (but is not limited to):
 - Women's 600 Club
