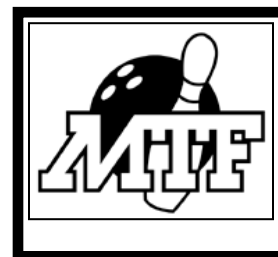

The Canadian Tenpin Federation has selected **Danielle Lemoine** and **Lynne Gauthier** as their Youth and Adult Bowlers of the Year for 2014.

Lemoine won 2-Gold, 1- Silver and 1- Bronze medal at the Canadian Youth Championships and was awarded the Chris Tucker Memorial Sportsmanship Award. Danielle was also a member of Team Canada's Adult Women's team that won a Silver medal at the PABCON Championships.

Gauthier won the Masters title at the PABCON Pan Am Olympic Festival and added two bronze medals - one in doubles and one in mixed doubles, while finishing fourth in Singles and fifth in All Events during the event. During the PABCON Ladies Championships, Lynne had a fourth place finish in doubles and won a Silver medal in the Team discipline. At the Canadian National World Cup finals Lynne finished second and reached the podium once again at the Canadian National Team Trials, finishing third. Lynne will also be travelling to Abu Dhabi for the Women's World Championships in early December/15.

One of our local bowlers, Leigha Carnivale, was featured in a story in one of our local area newspapers just before Leigha left to bowl for Team Canada in the Tournament of Americas.



It all started for **Leigha Carnevale** when she was nine years old. "In elementary school I had a friend who had grandparents who bowled. I went with them one night. After that my friend's parents spoke to my parents and I've been in a league ever since," she recalls.

Leigha Carnevale, 20, was a member of Team Canada at the PABCON youth championships in Panama. Leigha is now 20 years old and a member of the Canadian Tenpin Federation's 2015 youth Team Canada. "Half of the members of the team were from Manitoba — **Mitch Hupe, Sean Coutts, Stephanie Adams** and myself. One of our coaches, **Mike Boroskae**, was from Manitoba as well." The team recently returned from a very successful trip to Panama at the Pan-American Bowling Confederation (PABCON) Youth Championships.

"I finished fifth in singles, we won a silver in doubles, finished fourth in trios and won bronze in team. We also broke three Canadian Tenpin Federation records. We had a wonderful trip."

"My parents and sister are wonderful; they have done a lot for me. I would also like to thank my coach, **Mike Boroskae**. He is the one who got me to where I am. Also my friend **Lynne Gauthier** - she has helped me a lot with my mental game."

Leigha bowls out of Chateau Lanes and puts in a lot of time on the alley. "I bowl in two leagues right now, next year I will be bowling in three. I also practice twice a week with my coach. In total right now I bowl four nights a week; come Fall it will be five times a week."

There is no question Leigha loves the sport. "I am going to bowl as long as possible, until I can't walk," she says.

Whether young or old, Leigha offers this to help with your bowling game: *"Try to have fun. It can get frustrating and difficult, but stick with it. Do not give up; it's really worth it if you put time and dedication into it."*

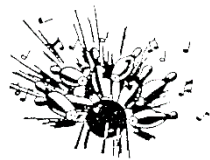

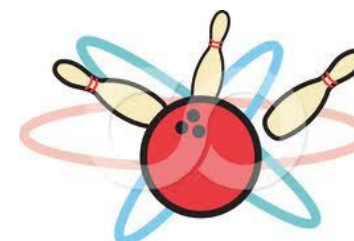
