Bowling was one of Sherry's greatest loves. Through it she met so many so many people, made so many friends, and it took her all over the Americas representing Canada.

From fun girls trips to Fargo in the winter; (no one was better at driving home through a blizzard than Sherry); to WIBC Championships in Tucson and Milwaukee, to the World Masters Games in Edmonton, to representing Canada at the Tournament of the Americas in Florida and at the PABCON Senior

Championships; so many memories were made travelling with bowling. There were horse races in the pool in Tucson, Bulldogs at Sunset Lanes in Moorhead, Trivia at TGI Fridays in Fargo and searching for "The Red Door" in Milwaukee. There was always tons of laughter and it was all the more fun because of Sherry.

Sherry also had a lot of success representing Canada. Her first international success came at the World Masters Games in Edmonton in 2005 where she won numerous medals including a gold in the masters event. She went on to represent Canada at the Tournament of the Americas four times in 2007, 2010, 2011, and 2013 winning 9 medals in the seniors division, including golds in singles and women's doubles and silvers in doubles and all events. She represented Canada at the PABCON Senior Championships in Medellin, Colombia in 2011 and the International Senior Open in Las Vegas in 2012 winning bronze medals in the women's trios in both.

Probably her most prized awards though, were being named the 2007 Canadian Female Bowler of the Year and the 2010 Canadian Senior Female Bowler of the Year. Sherry's passion for bowling was not limited to competing and for this we were all very fortunate. Sherry was very involved in the local bowling community - sitting on boards, running tournaments and leagues, organizing golf fund raisers, and managing Chateau Lanes. She took her passion and organizational skills further though, becoming involved with CTF, the Canadian Tenpin Federation.

Cathy Innes, former president of the CTF and current High Performance Committee Chair, is a very good friend of Sherry's and shared the following about Sherry's involvement with the CTF:

"Sherry was on the CTF board in the most important times (in my opinion); the early days when we first broke off from the USA. She was so important in the building process. She was the Membership Chair and was involved in the Hall of Fame, Bowler of the Year, Tournament and International Committees. She also introduced the Senior bowler of the year award and now it is a regular part of the program.

When Sherry retired from the board I was heartbroken because I came to rely on her for her candid perspective on issues and the fact that she really cared about bowling in Canada. Most importantly she became a close friend.

When she retired I appointed her as tournament director for the Canadian Mixed Championships and Team Trials which she did for 7 years. She also was an integral part of the Pan Am Committee for the 2015 Toronto Pan Am Games."

But more than the success she had competing and the difference she made from her involvement, Sherry cherished the friendships and memories she made along the way. She touched so many people with her caring and sincerity, her infectious laughter and her love of a good time. She has made so many good friends across Canada. Bowling is just not going to be the same without her.

Sherry left us much too soon but we are all richer for having had her in our lives. She taught us important lessons by how she lived her life. What we've learned from Sherry:

- A bad day on the lanes or the golf course is still a great day because it is spent with friends.
- A Monte Cristo coffee is the perfect end to a meal - decaf of course!
- There is nothing better than a good glass of red wine.
- Dance whenever you get the chance and always dance like no one is watching.
- Laugh often.
- Never, ever act your age.
- Life is short – live each day fully and with joy.

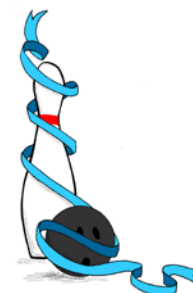

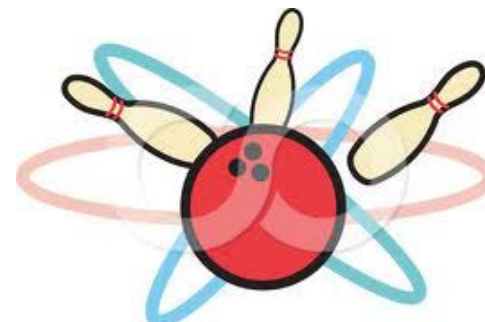

A clinic can be organized for a group of 6 - 12 bowlers and can be held at the bowling centre that best accommodates your group.

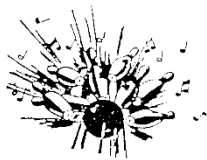
