

# **Gord Tereck – Perfect Game**




## **Lorna Lisowski - New Career High Series**

#### Who?


Application deadlines for all regions are **April 30th and October 15th** of each year. Winnipeg Region and Westman Region also have an additional application deadline of **July 15th.** Based on demonstrated need, assistance of up to \$300 per individual is available to children between the ages of 5 and 18 to help offset the cost of registration fees. Provincial Sport Organizations must recognize planned activities.

# Jersey Galapon – 111 Pins Over Average Game




Congratulations to **Jersey Galapon** from the Mabuhay Mixed Bowling League.
