For every 25 pins over 750 and every 10 pins over 800 an additional 1 point will be awarded (e.g. 774 will get 7 points and 820 will get 11 points)

OTHER RULES AND CLARIFICATION

1	To qualify for bowler of the year, a bowler must be a permanent resident in Manitoba and bowl in a local league or bowl at least 3 local tournaments.
2	All tournaments must be CTF or USBC sanctioned
3	Points will be awarded for scratch tournaments and finishes only
4	Category #1 tournaments - points awarded for finish in any event (e.g. singles, doubles, trios, etc.). For team event, you must have bowled on the winning team.
5	For tournaments listed in categories 2 to 5, points will be awarded for achievements in any event. For doubles, trios and teams, points listed will be divided by the number of players in the event. (E.g. For doubles, points will be divided by 2.) For team event, you must have bowled on the winning team.
6	Where tournaments have separate divisions for boys and girls (e.g. Team Trials & MJBT), separate points will be awarded
7	Where a tournament has no gender divisions (e.g. Youth Open), points will be based on final standings and will be awarded only once for boys and girls combined
8	All sanctioned (CTF or USBC) record scores (1 and 3 game) bowled in youth leagues and tournaments will be counted
9	Record scores bowled in any adult league or tournament will NOT be counted
10	Points will be awarded for record scores each time they are bowled
11	Any tournament not explicitly listed in this criteria will be included in the category deemed appropriate by the MBA
12	The term "any tournament" used in this criteria excludes tournaments listed specifically elsewhere
13	Points will be accumulated from September 1 to August 31 of the following year
14	It is the bowler's responsibility to submit tournament results and record scores to the MBA and their league secretary
15	Points for tournaments are awarded in each division where applicable (bantam, prep, junior, intermediate and senior)
