Two types of clinics are offered:



They are estimating that they will have over 8000 athletes in attendance that will be competing in over 60 sports and Tenpin Bowling is one of them!

The bowling events consists of Singles, Doubles, and 4-person Teams, and of course, All-Events. There are 3 different average categories, with Gender divisions, and a Masters category (age 50+) as well. There is no handicapping. The bowling takes place at Chateau Lanes, from July 31st – Aug 2nd. There are Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medals awarded for each category/event. One of the unique aspects of this tournament is that the Top 5 All-Events scores, regardless of age or gender, are pitted against each other in a TV-style roll-off at the end of each of the competitions.



The Manitoba Open took place on Jan. 13th, 14th and 15th with bowlers from across Canada as well as North Dakota. The new format of 6 Game Blocks with Re-Entry continues to be very successful. The 3 qualifying shifts garnered 86 total entries. After Friday and Saturday's 6 game blocks, the cut line for the top 24 was 1212. Top Qualifier was tied between Mitch Hupe & Michael Makela with 1306.

Sunday's match-play finals consisted of 8 games plus a stepladder finish for the top 5. 2023 Manitoba Open Winner is **Austyn Ducharme from Winnipeg. Positions 2 through 5 were: Michael Makela (TBay), Daniel Skitt (Alta), Mitch Hupe (Wpg) and Marissa Naylor (Wpg).** With \$6,000.00 in added sponsorship money, the tournament paid a 1st Place Prize of \$2,000.00 and almost \$15,000.00 in total payout. Austyn also threw a 300 Game on Sunday. BOWLING HALL OF FAME OF MANITOBA



Historical Milestones of Tenpin Bowling in Manitoba

St. Boniface Cercle Ouvrier 6 lane Tenpin Bowling Centre was located near the corner of Tache Avenue and Cathedrale Avenue from 1930s to 1970c. This bowling community had close ties with The Church, which offered the land upon which to build the bowling centre. The building was constructed by electricians, construction workers, carpenters from the bowling community, hence the name *Cercle Ouvrier*, which translates to “*Workers Circle*” ie. A Group of Working Men.

In 1970c., for reasons unknown, The Church withdrew its offer to have the building on their property and it was quickly torn down, but the concrete foundation remained there for another 30+ years. The eviction of this strong bowling community led to the establishment of Club LaVerendrye at the other end of Cathedrale Avenue on Des Meurons Street in 1972.
