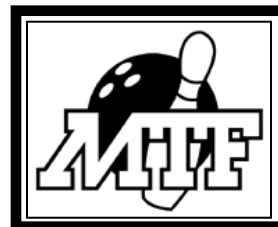

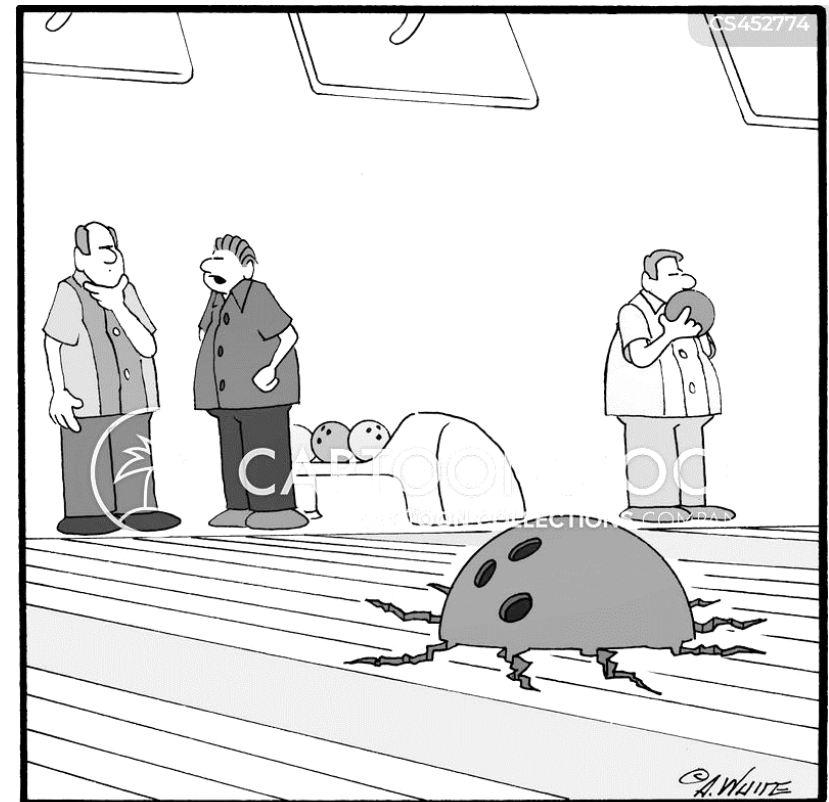
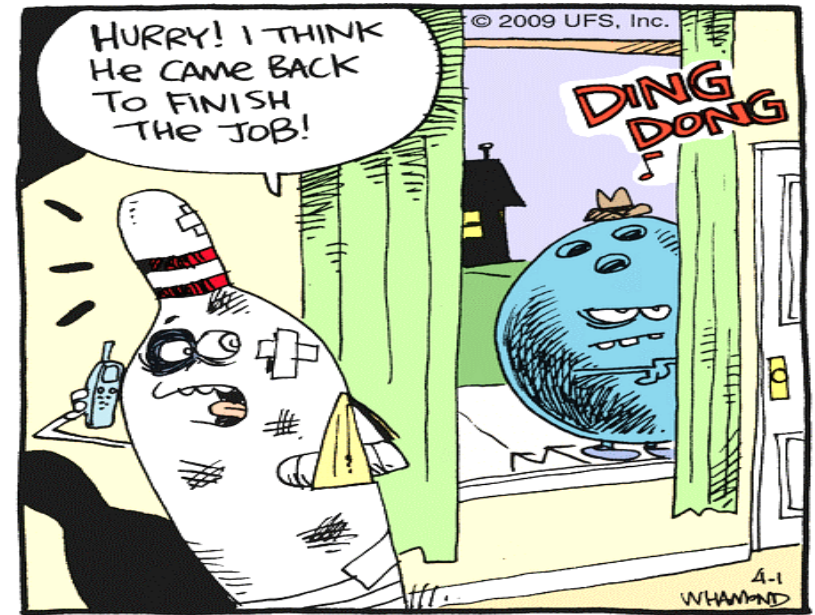

2023 World Police and Fire Games Being Hosted in Winnipeg

We are pleased to announce that the 2023 World Police and Fire Games (WPFG), which will be the largest sporting event ever held in Manitoba, will be taking place from July 28th to Aug 6th, 2023. They are estimating that they will have over 8000 athletes in attendance that will be competing in over 60 sports and Tenpin Bowling is one of them!

The bowling events consists of Singles, Doubles, and 4-person Teams, and of course, All-Events. There are 3 different average categories, with Gender divisions, and a Masters category (age 50+) as well. There is no handicapping. The bowling takes place at Chateau Lanes, from July 31st – Aug 2nd. There are Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medals awarded for each category/event. One of the unique aspects of this tournament is that the Top 5 All-Events scores, regardless of age or gender, are pitted against each other in a TV-style roll-off at the end of each of the competitions.

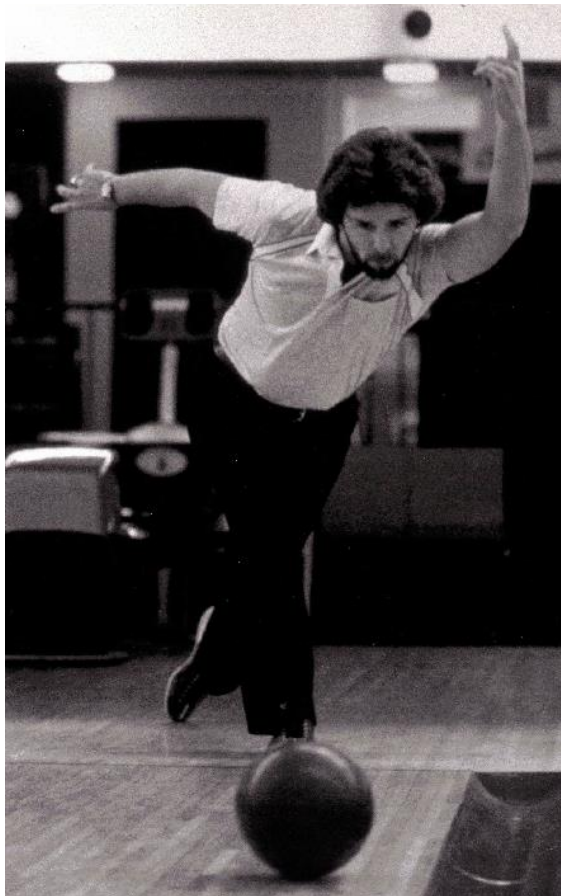

Bea Finney – One of Manitoba's Top Competitive Women Bowlers 1940-50's. Choose to compete men's tournaments for several years and excelled.

She was one of the founding members of the Winnipeg Women's Bowling Association and was a director on that board for over 15 years (1948-64), serving as President from 1951-56.

Bea was inducted into the Bowling Hall of Fame of Manitoba in 2000 under both the Individual Achievement & Meritorious Service categories.

Irene Leonard - In 1944-45 Irene started Tenpin Bowling at the Circle Ouvrier Club in St. Boniface. 1946-48 Irene joined the Senior Mixed & Bowl Arena Mixed and also competed in many other leagues later on over her bowling career.

In 1949-50 the Winnipeg Women's Bowling Association was formed; Irene was one of the founding members and served as one of its first directors. From 1953-69, Irene held the position of Secretary with the Winnipeg Women's Bowling Association for those 16 years.

In 1950 Irene bowled the first 700 Three Game Series for women in Manitoba and Western Canada (2nd in Canada).

Irene was inducted into the Bowling Hall of Fame of Manitoba in 2000 under the Meritorious Service category.

Historical Milestones of Tenpin Bowling in Manitoba

Q – Who was one of the founders of organized bowling in Winnipeg and Manitoba and did much to foster the game in Western Canada by opening several centers from Fort William /Port Arthur (Thunder Bay) to Vancouver. - Formed the first league in Manitoba in 1906. - Was a founding board member of the Winnipeg Bowling Association in 1917 and was the first to be named an Honorary Life Member of the WBA in 1918. -Was a top city bowler & the 3rd Manitoban to roll a 300 Game.



A – **Charles Gibson** (above – c.1915) - He and his two sons built, owned & operated several Bowling Centres in Winnipeg (*including Saratoga Lanes in 1906 at age 25*) up until the 1950's. Much is owed to him and the Gibson family towards the early development of our sport in Winnipeg and across Western Canada. Charles was inducted in 2000 under the *Certificate of Appreciation* category.

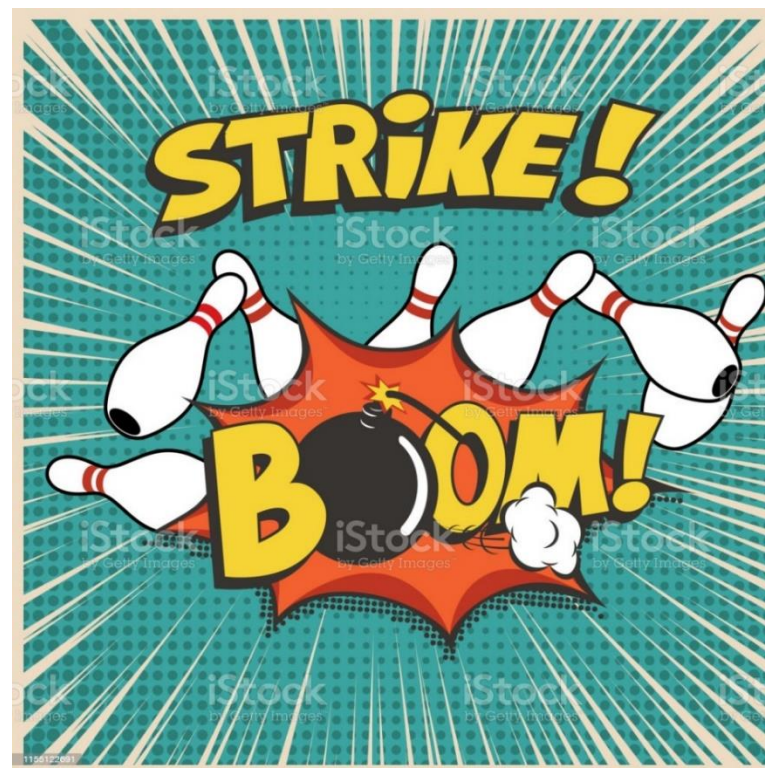

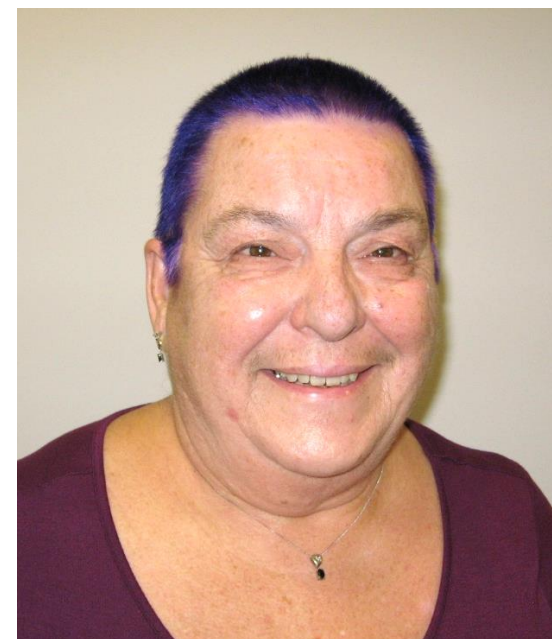
