



The last Silver Medal in a World Championships for the ladies team was in 2013 by the trios team of Samantha How, Isabelle Rioux, Caroline Lagrange. Almost a decade later Sarah Klassen won Bronze in Singles in 2021.





Long-time volunteer & competitive bowler of over 5 decades, who could hold her own against the top male bowlers of the 1940's to early 70's; winning and top finishing in countless scratch and handicap tournaments until her passing in the early 2000's. She also personally supported youth bowling development through provincial scholarships & coaching at the Canadian German Society Bowling Lanes (Now *Bowl Below*).
