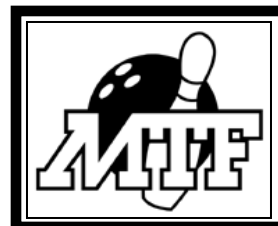

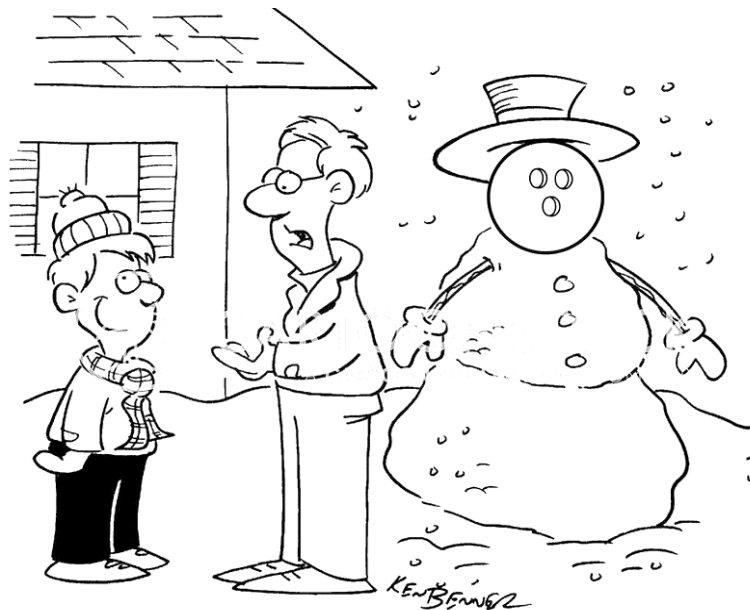

The last Silver Medal in a World Championships for the ladies team was in 2013 by the trios team of Samantha How, Isabelle Rioux, Caroline Lagrange. Almost a decade later Sarah Klassen won Bronze in Singles in 2021.

16th Association Challenge – 2023

On October 21, 2023 the Dauphin Tenpin Association hosted the Annual Association Challenge that also included Winnipeg Tenpin Bowling Association and Brandon Tenpin Bowling Association.

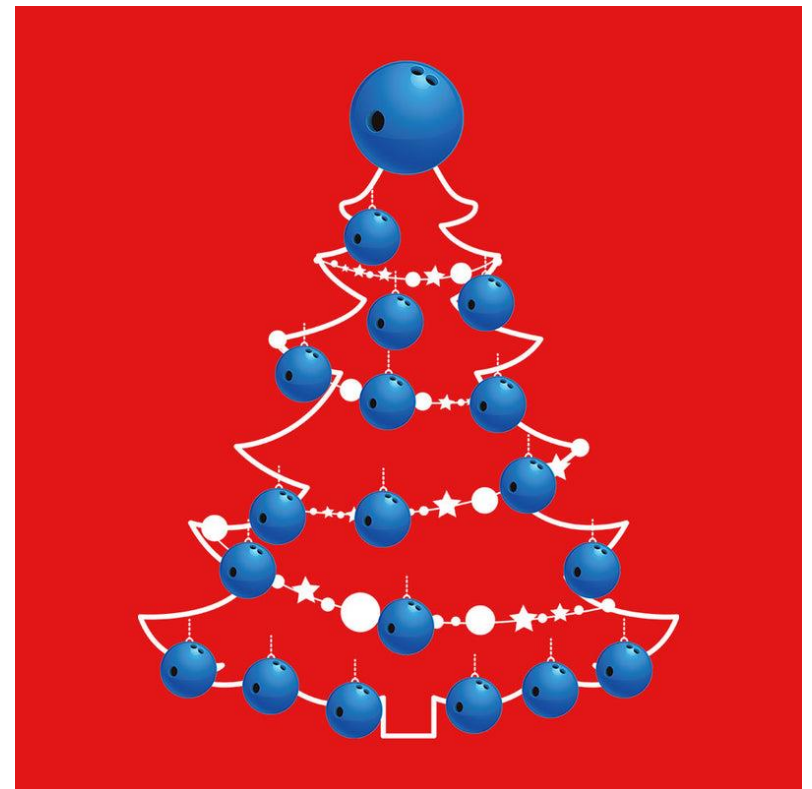

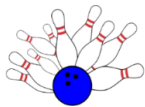

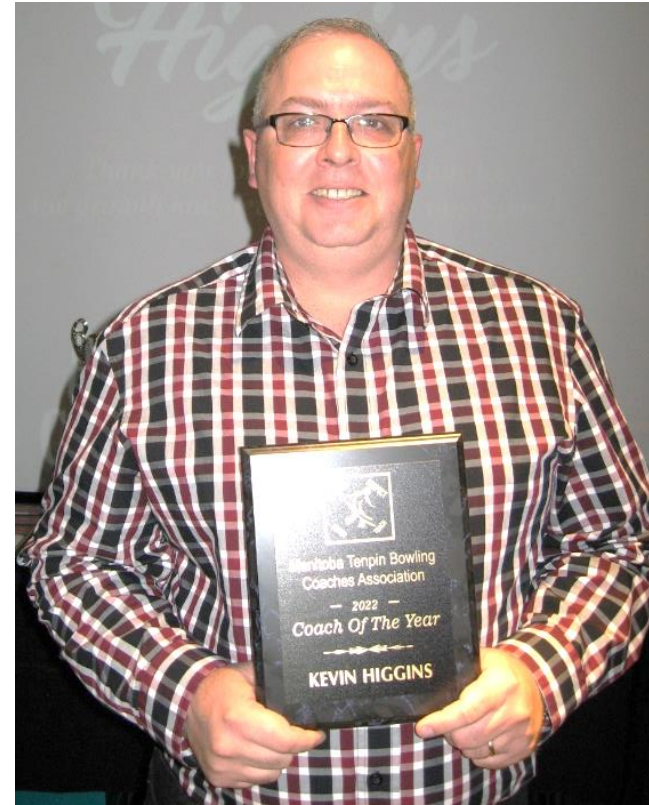
